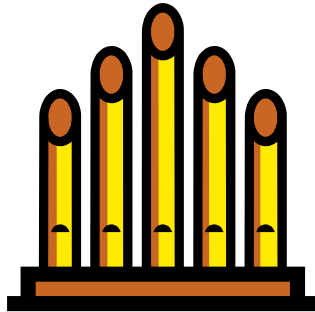

At the **Good Vibrations** exhibit, experiment with changing the frequency and volume.

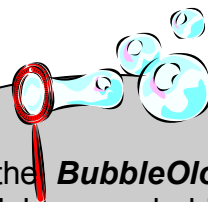

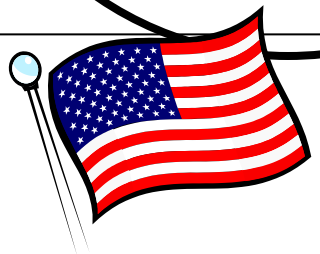

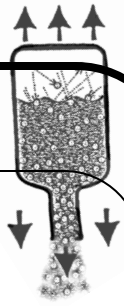
Go to the Hall of Illusions

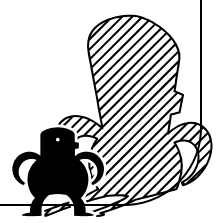


FROZEN SHADOWS ROOM
