

Behavior & Expectations At ScienceWorks

Acknowledgment and Consent:

- My child and I understand that in order to ensure a safe and positive environment for all participants, ScienceWorks has a few safety rules. Please read these rules together with your child:

The Three Main Rules:

ScienceWorks Hands-On Museum follows three main rules for this program as follows:

- **BE SAFE** - My child agrees to follow all safety rules while at ScienceWorks, including walking in the museum, exploring in permitted areas, respecting barriers, treating exhibits gently, and refraining from roughhousing, violent language or behavior, and disrupting others' experience in the museum.
- **BE KIND** - ScienceWorks sees visitors from 0 - 100 on a regular basis. Some of those visitors may be in the museum while my child is at ScienceWorks. My child agrees to help make the museum visit experience positive by using kind words and actions.
- **BE RESPONSIBLE:** - Students visiting the museum during this time can exercise responsibility by keeping areas tidy after using them, reporting any broken or damaged exhibits, respecting all safety rules, and setting a great example for each other and any younger visitors.
- Unlike most ScienceWorks youth programs, Middle School Club House does not require adult chaperones and does not have an assigned facilitator. ScienceWorks staff and volunteers will be present to lightly supervise and to respond to behavioral concerns.
- Serious or regular infractions may result in a variety of outcomes, such as the guardian being called, an adult chaperone being required to attend the program with their child, or in rare cases, a child not being allowed to participate in the program.
